

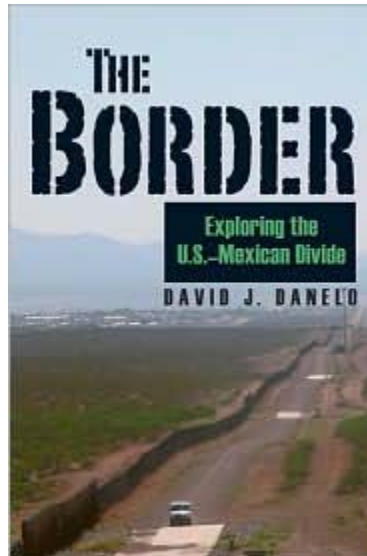

By Author, David Danelo

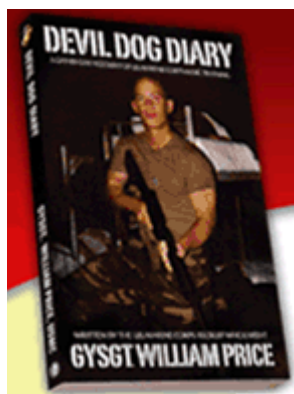

During this trip he interviewed Border Patrol agents, local politicians, immigration activists, deported migrants, and religious officials.

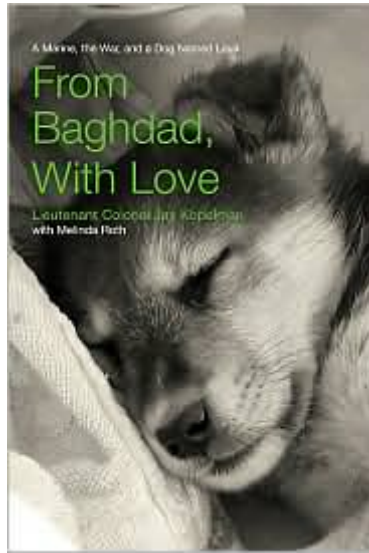
“Devil Dog Diary”

GySgt Price will be available to sign copies of the “Devil Dog Diary”. Purchase price per book is \$20.00, with a percentage going to MCFU.



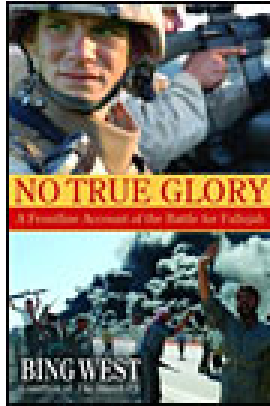
From Bagdad, With Love: A Marine, the War and a Dog Named Lava
