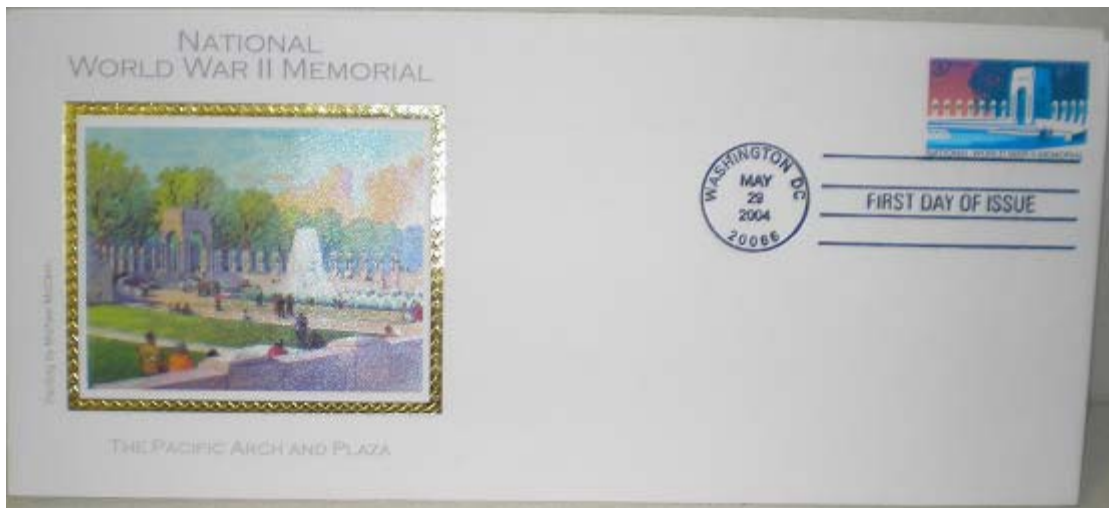

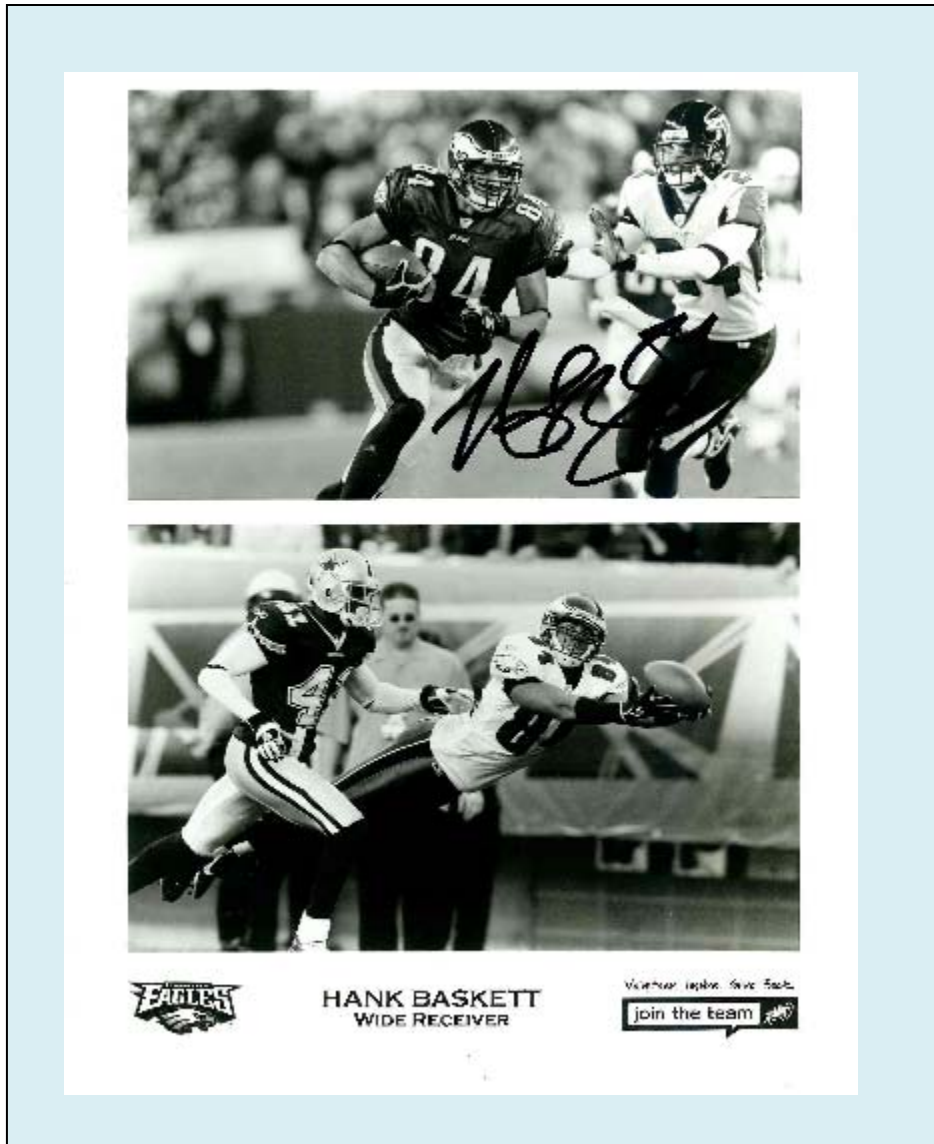

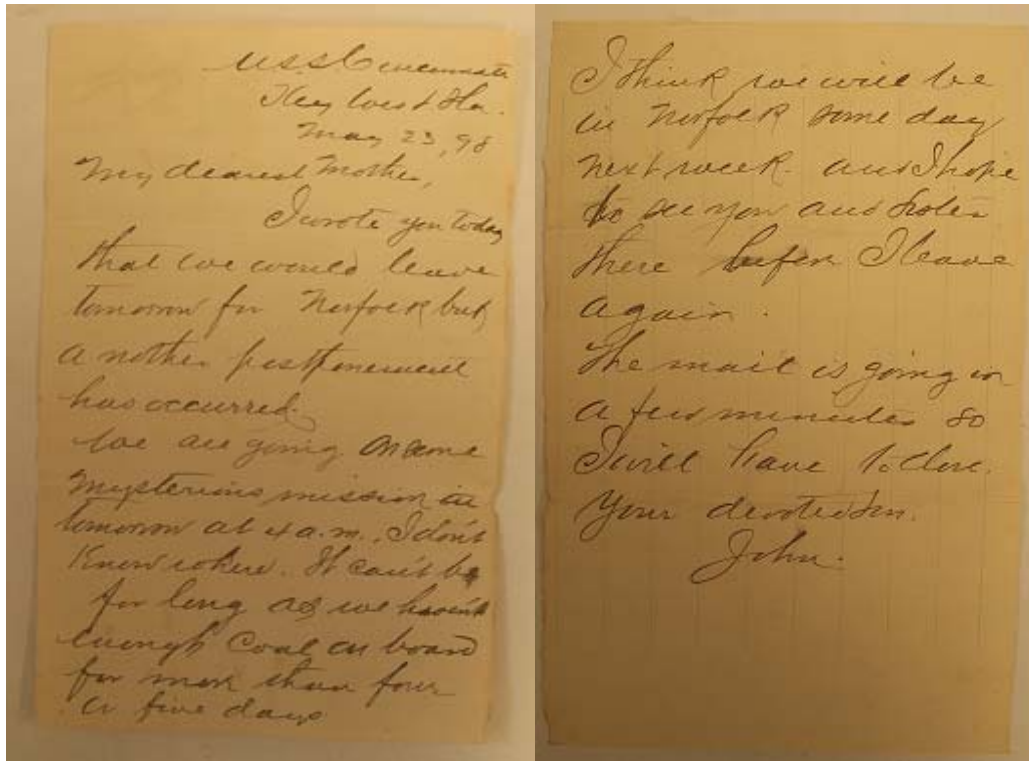

John A. Lejeune (1867-1942)

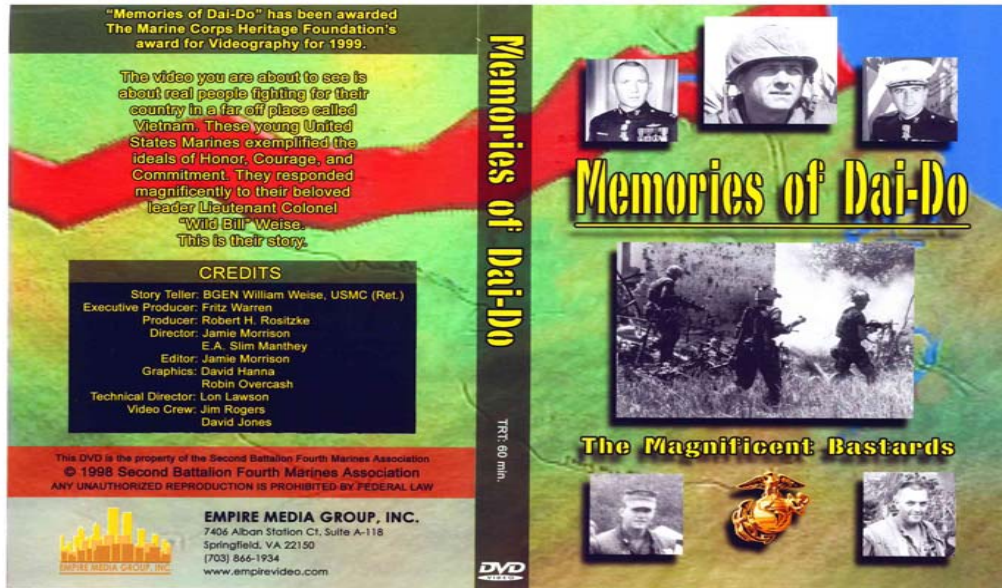
#### Handwritten Letter

John Lejeune—Major General and 13th Commandant of the U.S. Marine Corps (1920-1929), distinguished Commander of Marine Corps Second Division in WWI and Eponym for the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune in North Carolina.

This letter was written to his mother from onboard the USS *Cincinnati* where he was captain of the Marine Guard. Interesting content mentions leaving on a mysterious mission the following day, “We are going on some mysterious mission tomorrow at 4AM. I don’t know where. It can’t be for long as we haven’t enough coal on board for more than four or five days.” Boldly penned and signed in full – “Your Devoted Son, John”.

Written during the Spanish-American War, the letter is two pages, front and back, handwritten on single leaf torn from a 5” x 7-½” notebook. Dated March 23, 1898 and sent from the USS *Cincinnati* then in Key West, Florida. Letter is in good condition with normal mailing folds.
